God loved people.






God loves everyone (the world).














God's Word shows that some things demand evidence:

That He did not just give any prophet.








That He also did not just give an angel.

"God's Son" is a title.

Luke 1:30-35



The title "God's Son" appears in the Old Testament:

Proverbs 30:4

Psalms 2:7



Two verses in the Old Testament describe a person:

Who is a human and also God Himself.

Isaiah 9:6-7





Jesus Christ was physically human,

And spiritually God Himself.

John 1:1,14



When the Jewish High Priest asked Jesus:

"Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?"

Jesus said "I am."

Mark 14:61b-62a



The Jews understood Jesus' answer as blasphemy

And decided to condemn Him to death.

For what purpose did He give His Son?


To live among us

To be a sacrifice for the forgiveness of our sins






For what purpose did He give His Son?

?



God's Word says there is an eternal Hell:

Matthew 25:41

Revelation 20:10-15





Whoever does not believe in Jesus Christ will perish:

"He who does not obey the Son will not see life"

John 3:36b





Will our "good works" not save us from Hell?

Will our "good works" not erase our sins?





It does not say, "those with good works will not perish"

This verse excludes "good works" entirely.


Doing good deeds is everyone's duty anyway!

Will have everlasting life.








But didn't faith demand evidence?

They show their love.














